"Is the manor landscape a landscape that contains a historical manor, a positive deposit?

Latvia and Estonia have a comparable history of manor management and land use, they have a comparable structure of landscapes and settlements, as well as the overlap of this structure with the socialist collective farm, which accordingly affects its current form under the current agricultural policy.

As a result of this, structures of landscapes and settlements were formed, that radically broke the previous distribution of assets and reflected the prevailing socio-political ideology of that time. Given the constant decrease in population and the related decline in the importance of rural areas, economic reorientation could help express identity and pride."
